THY ROD AND THY STAFF THEY COMFORT ME.

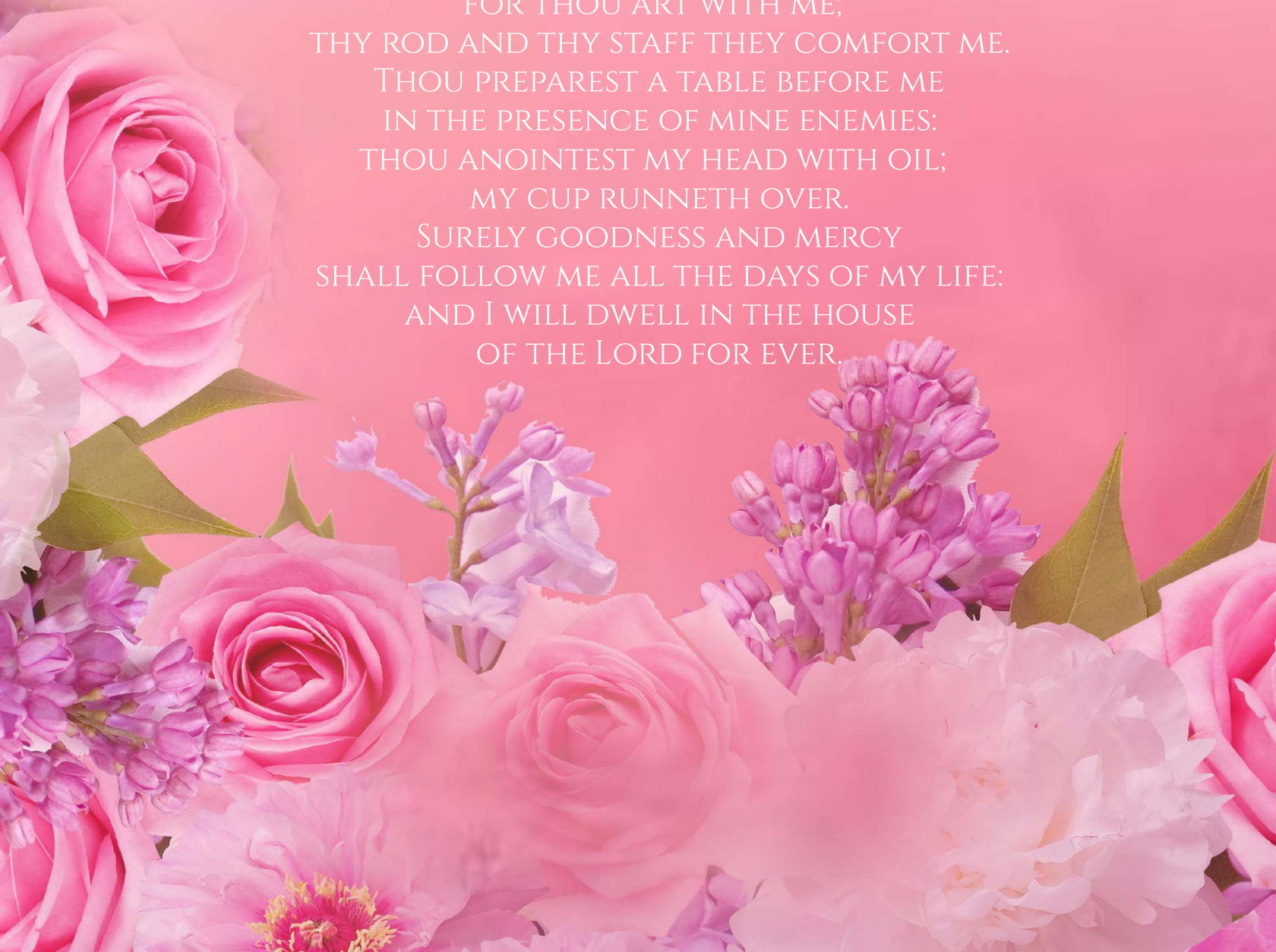
THOU PREPAREST A TABLE BEFORE ME
